IF SO, REFER THEM TO OUR PROGRAM TO GET THE FOLLOWING SERVICES:



- Comprehensive medical assessment, including past medical history and a physical exam as needed and addressing primary care concerns that may arise while in the program
- Blood work, if not completed within the last 3 months
- Mental health diagnoses according to the DSM-V
- Initiate, titrate, or augment psychotropic medications, as necessary
- Counselling services up to 12 sessions
- Appropriate referral to internal
- and/or external resources as necessary
- Navigate and connect to community programs



The team is composed of a Nurse

Practitioner and a Mental Health

Therapist who work side by side to strengthen the integration of primary care services and improve access to care in the Durham Region for individuals struggling with mental illness.



Duration of service typically extends from several months, with consultative services and ongoing support provided as needed. You will receive comprehensive reports from the MH-IPC team upon the patient's discharge from the program.
